CHS recognizes the importance of breastmilk for babies and toddlers. If you are currently breastfeeding and would like to continue to pump and save your breastmilk, you **MUST** commit to the following rules. If you are unable to meet the below criteria you will be allowed to express milk, however, the milk will not be stored.

Criteria:

- Must have a consistent and committed designated caregiver to pick up the milk on an agreed upon schedule
- Have a negative HIV and drug test
- Agree to random drug testing
- Cannot be on medication that contraindicates breastfeeding
- You must pump regularly

Rules:

- Milk that cannot be frozen immediately will be discarded. (ie. Traveling to court)
- You are responsible to clean pump supplies (Medical staff will store supplies)
- You are only able to pump in designated pumping area
- Upon release breastmilk must be picked up within 3 days
